She Orchestra's Annual Report covers a summary of its activities and highlights for the period from 1 April 2003 to 31 March 2004. It also includes the presentation of financial statements and an auditors' report for the year ended 31 March 2004. The Report seeks to achieve the high level of transparency and disclosure of information expected from an organization that works to fulfill its obligations and that is accountable to the public and other stakeholders.

Overall Performance

During the year, the Orchestra achieved more with less. Despite a further reduction in government funding, the number of concerts that were held increased by 82% compared to the previous year. We have also recorded a significant audience growth and a substantial increase in actual income. The audience

growth was boosted by an increased number of commissioned concerts.

Such achievements have much to do with the strong support from sponsors and donors. The total amount of sponsorships and donations received in the past year nearly doubled that of the previous year. As a result of this generous support, the Orchestra has become much stronger. The tremendous efforts made by Council Members and staff in securing these new sponsorships and donations, and in enhancing revenue from business activities, have been critical in achieving this remarkable performance.

Working Towards World Class Orchestra Status

In sustaining the momentum of working towards our mission of becoming a world-class orchestra, we continued our efforts, inter



alia, to expand the number of performances and explore new frontiers.

This year the Orchestra was invited by the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office to perform at the Natural History Museum in London as Cultural Ambassador of Hong Kong. This was the second time we have been invited by the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office to perform overseas, an earlier concert having been given in Washington DC.

In June this year, we had another opportunity to tour in Europe. We were invited to perform at "Saint-Denis Arts Festival - The Year of China in France". Our performance won acclaim from many parties.

We were also invited for the first time by China Mobile Communications Corporation and Xian Baoyou Communications Corporation to give New Year Concert Tours in the Pearl River Delta and Xian respectively. These tours marked the opening up of new opportunities in China and we are poised to explore more new markets in the future.

Hong Kong Spirit and the Orchestra

Last year marked a difficult year for the Orchestra because of the constraint in funding. Yet it was even more difficult for Hong Kong as a whole. The outbreak of SARS depressed both the economy and community morale in Hong Kong. The Orchestra therefore joined hands with the Government to organize the "Hong Kong Drum Festival" to uplift the mood of the community. Sharing joy with others is always better than having fun alone. This programme was met with much enthusiasm and was considered a great success.

Nurturing of Young Players

The Orchestra has always been committed to musical education as we are convinced it plays a vital part in holistic development. We also believe that the earlier budding musicians receive musical training, the better. Towards this end, we have organized various instrument training courses for youngsters, notably the series of courses "Introduction to Chinese Instruments".

The courses were well received by youngsters and parents. We are pleased to see that enrolment has been trending upwards since the inception of the courses and we will continue our efforts to sustain the impetus.

In order to extend the benefits of musical education to more youngsters, the Orchestra has set up scholarships and financial assistance to enable those talented youngsters who have financial difficulties to develop their potential.

m O ince the mid-70s, the Hong Kong government and people involved in cultural activities have strived to provide diversified art programmes for the Hong Kong public. Today, Hong Kong's cultural activities are flourishing. Different forms of art continue to emerge, enhancing the cultural life of Hong Kong citizens. With its roots in traditional Chinese culture, the Orchestra has always been committed to promoting Chinese music, ever since its establishment in 1977. However, in the 21st century, in the face of the emergence of social restructuring, global financial turmoil and various contagious diseases, the Orchestra, as a governmentfunded organization, can no longer remain with the previous linear mode of thinking. It has to strike a balance among corporate revenue, audience cognition and social mission so as to achieve mutiple directions of development and take new initiatives. We have to ensure that our performance remains professional but at the same time we need to ascertain the audience's appreciation of Chinese music and lead them to acquire more knowledge of it. This will enable us to fulfill our social duties and mission more effectively.

Organizing the Drum Festival has been a concept in my mind for years. The concept was finally realized during the year. There were four concerts in the Festival which introduced the drum culture of China and that of other countries. In addition, there were other activities involving participation by the public. We believe that "Sharing joy with others is always better than having fun alone". We aim to enable the

public to appreciate the beauty of Chinese music through interactive participation. Three thousand drummers and members of the general public, musicians and executives of the Orchestra and VIPs worked together to cheer the Hong Kong people to strive for a bounce back in the post-SARS period. I was gratified and felt encouraged to see that the Drum Festival has not only been a cultural activity, but also a valuable contribution to society.

According to the findings from the survey that we commissioned The Hong Kong Polytechnic University to conduct in the previous year, knowledge of instruments and music helps to enhance the audience's interest in and understanding of concerts. The development of educational programmes has become a core part in promoting Chinese musical culture. I am pleased to see that the Hong Kong Children Chinese Orchestra and the Chinese Instrument Courses which were introduced a year ago received tremendous support from the public. During the year, the Orchestra published a book entitled The Enjoyment of Chinese Orchestral Music. Apart from introducing Chinese musical instruments, the publication also presents information about Chinese music and composers. Commissioning new works plays a critical part in promoting the status of Chinese orchestral music. Solely commissioning new works without enhancing the appreciation ability of the public will only lead to a



situation where "highbrow songs find few followers". In view of this. the Orchestra has opened a new post for a Research Fellow responsible for the advancement of muscial appreciation. The Orchestra derives its music from compositions and a particular composition derives its melody from instruments. The improvement and development of Chinese musical instruments play an important role in the furtherance of a large-scale Chinese orchestra. I wish to, therefore, convey a special note of thanks to the Council for its support, for creating a new post for an instruments development researcher.

Struck by SARS in the first half of the year, the Orchestra had to make some rearrangements to its scheduled programmes, inter alia, reshuffling the performance dates of special performances and concert tours. During the period from November to December, apart from attending rehearsals and performing at nine shows of the musical "Sweet and Sour Hong Kong", the Orchestra also performed at the "Global Chinese Composers in Concert" - Opening Concert of the "2003 Chinese Composers' Festival" and two concert tours. During the concert tours, I made certain rearrangements to the Orchestra setting to suit the specific designs of different performing venues so as to obtain the best acoustic effect. The schedule of the concert tour in the Pearl River Delta was particularly demanding, with a different venue for each performance. Members of the Orchestra were exhausted moving from one location to the next. The concerts were enthusiastically received and this reffects the cohesion of the Orchestra.

The ample room for creativity given to me is a result of the full support from the Council, recognition from the public and dedication of each and every colleague in the Artistic Team and Executive Team. I would like to take this opportunity to express my heartfelt gratitude to all of the above.

於 70 年代中,香港政府及文 化界人士不斷努力為香港市民 提供多元化的藝術節目,至今,香 港文化事業發展蓬勃,不同藝術形 式的表演層出不窮,為市民的心靈 生活注入營養。香港中樂團植根中 國傳統文化,於1977年成立後, 一直以推廣中國音樂文化為己任。 然而,踏入21世紀e-時代,社會 的轉型、全球金融風暴及不同疫症 的出現,在種種客觀環境的變化 下,作為香港政府資助的唯一職業 中樂團,我們在藝術發展的方向 上,已不能根據以往單線條的思維 方式,而必須在公司利潤、觀眾認 知和社會使命三方面中取得平衡, 從而作多方面的發展和嘗試。在確

定樂團的藝術表現為專業及高雅的 同時,我們亦需要知道觀眾的認 知,帶領他們,令樂團更有效益地 達成我們的社會責任和使命。

舉辦鼓樂節是我多年來的構想, [2003 香港鼓樂節] 於年內終於能 成功舉辦。鼓樂節中除設立4場介 紹中國鼓和其他國家鼓文化的音樂 會外,更加入很多讓市民一同參與 的活動。我們深信「獨樂樂,不如 眾樂樂!」,希望透過互動參與, 讓廣大市民認識和親身體會中國音 樂文化之美。三千名鼓手及廣大市 民、樂團各樂師及行政人員與特別 嘉賓在高溫和煦麗的陽光下,仍眾 志成城,齊心協力地擊鼓為香港人 打氣,互相激發在非典型肺炎之疫 後重新振作。鼓樂節在提供文化活 動的同時,亦能發揮它的社會功能 回饋社會,這一切實在令我覺得很 欣慰和鼓舞!

根據去年樂團委托理工大學進行的 觀眾意見調查所得,對樂器及樂曲 的認識有助觀眾欣賞音樂會的興趣 和理解。因此發展教育活動亦是推 動中國音樂文化重要的一環,我喜 見年前成立的兒童中樂團及樂器班 得到社會人士的支持。年內,樂團 特別策劃出版《中樂因您更動聽》一 書,內容除介紹中國樂器外,更向 讀者介紹部分中國樂曲和作曲家。 委約新創作是推動大型民族管弦樂 重要的一環,但光是創新作品,而 未能協助提高觀眾的欣賞能力便將 會出現「曲高和寡」的情況。因此, 樂團於年內設立研究員一職,協助 樂團研究推動教育導賞的工作。樂 團的聲音源於作品,作品的聲音源 自樂器。中國樂器的改良和發展同 樣在大型民族樂團的發展上,佔一 重要地位。因此,我特別感謝理事 會的支持,接受我的建議,於樂團 設立樂器改革研究主任一職。

由於上半年受到非典型肺炎的影 響,樂團的演出活動須作出應變調 整,其中包括調動演出檔期及加入 特别演出和外訪活動。於11月至12 月期間,樂團除參加音樂劇「酸酸 甜甜香港地」的排練和9場演出外, 還有「香港華人作曲家藝術節揭幕 音樂會」和兩次外訪演出活動。而 外訪期間,我均按不同演出場地的 設計,相對調整樂團的擺位,務求 能獲得更佳的聲響效果;再加上是 次廣東省珠江三角洲的巡迴演出行 程緊密,音樂會每天於不同城市舉 行,團員在疲累的狀態下,仍越戰 越勇,實在令我感動!音樂會獲得 各界人士的讚譽,這正反映了樂團 在融合訓練上的成果,齊心致力奉 獻卓越的中樂藝術,追求音樂至高 境界!

藝術的創意空間,有賴理事會的全 力支持,社會各界的認同,藝術部 和行政部每一位同事的熱誠投入。 我謹向各人致以萬分謝意。

 \mathcal{O} omeone asked me whether an arts administrator is an artist or an executive. My answer was, "it's a combination of both". A professional arts administrator needs to be devoted to the arts, be creative, and at the same time possess a clear mind to analyze and handle the many issues that arise in the day-to-day management work. The various aspects of arts administration are highly interrelated. While a level head and good inter-personal skills are deemed necessary for handling work of this nature, a sharp marketing sense and an ability to manage crises are also considered indispensable. The above are the principles that guided the Executive Team in administration of the Orchestra.

Since its incorporation in 2001, the Orchestra has been gradually perfecting both its administrative structure and management system. The Orchestra's activities have become more diverse in nature. The number of concerts and outreach performances has increased and new performance styles and themes have been introduced. Programmes to strengthen the promotion of Chinese music have been launched. These programmes have included the Hong Kong Children Chinese Orchestra, Chinese Instrument Courses, instrument research and development, publications to introduce the enjoyment of Chinese music as well as the production of various audio and video products. Indoor programmes have been transformed into large-scale

outdoor activities involving the participation of the general public. In addition, collaborative relationships with other organizations have extended beyond Hong Kong to other countries. These resulted in higher demands on the Executive Team's workload, in terms of both quantity and quality.

Like many other performing groups, the Orchestra is facing a challenge in managing its finances, as a result of difficult economic conditions and reduced government funding. Instead of a compromised reduction in the quality and quantity of our activities, we need to maximize our offerings and make the best use of limited resources. As a non-profitdistributing organization, the Orchestra continues to increase sources of income through different collaborations. It seeks to increase income from business activities in addition to the scheduled concerts, with a view to steadily improving its financial situation. These business activities include the provision of Chinese Instrument Courses for different groups and organizations and accompaniment for performances and films. Internally, we establish corporate management practices. Externally, we adopt a commercial approach without varying the core values and market position of the Orchestra. We adopt marketing strategies to promote easy understanding of the essence of Chinese music among the general public.

Owing to the outbreak of SARS



during the year, the Orchestra had to cancel some of its scheduled concerts. Yet through the carefully prepared contingency plans by the Executive Team and the Artistic Director, the Orchestra managed to continue its service to the public and consequently succeeded in fulfilling all requirements stated in its service contract while ensuring the health of all staff.

We are delighted that the Opening Rally of the "Hong Kong Drum Festival" was included as part of the campaign to relaunch Hong Kong's economy. Despite a reduction in preparation time by two months, the Executive Team spared no effort in preparing this event to fight against the economic recession and strive to bounce back after SARS. We arranged the manufacturing and transportation of the largest Chinese drum and gong. We worked round the clock to put in place over three thousand drums of various kinds at Victoria Park in Hong Kong. On the day of the performance, at a high temperature of 33℃, we continued to provide logistic support for the event. In addition to the Opening Rally, there were various other performances such as "Synergy Drum Competition", "Know Your Drumming Index - Drums to Test Your Mood", exhibitions and outdoor demonstration performances, which involved a tremendous amount of liaison work and risk management. With devotion to the art of music and public good, the Executive Team has brought to the fore the true meaning of the "Hong Kong Drum Festival" as a means to illustrate team spirit and high morale.

Finally, I would like to acknowledge the Council for its trust and guidance, the public for its support, members of the Artistic Team for their contribution and colleagues of the Executive Team for their dedication. Only with the assistance of all of the above parties could the arts administration work function effectively. 經有人問我,藝術行政人員是 屬於藝術工作者或是行政管理 人員,我的答案是兩者皆是。專業 的藝術行政人員,既要擁有熱衷於 藝術的奉獻精神和創意,亦要具備 清晰的頭腦去分析和應付繁瑣的管 理工作。藝術行政工作,環環相 扣,除了需要穩健清晰的頭腦和善 於與人溝通的社交能力外,還要有 敏鋭的市場觸角和危機處理能力。

面對社會經濟壓力,政府資助逐漸 減少,樂團與香港其他演藝團體一 樣,在財務處理上面對另一考驗。 但我們深信,若在資源減少的情況 下,減少樂團的活動數量或減低質 量,只會造成惡性循環,樂團須在 有限的資源,作無限的伸延,從而 獲得更多社會支持。作為非分配利 潤組織,樂團於年內不斷開拓新的 收入來源,透過不同的合作關係, 增加樂團定期音樂會以外的收入, 務求令樂團的財務狀況穩健求進, 如為不同機構及團體提供樂器訓練 班、電影配樂、演出伴奏等。樂團 對內企業化,對外商業化,商業化 並非俗化,亦非改變樂團活動的質 量及市場定位,行銷形式商業化只 是向廣大市民提供易於掌握的解讀

程序,讓他們更易理解中國音樂文 化的神髓。

於年內,樂團亦無可避免地受到非 典型肺炎的影響而取消部分音樂 會,樂團行政部與藝術總監透過審 慎 周 密 的 應 變 計 劃 , 在 確 保 樂 團 各 職員健康的同時,亦履行了樂團在 服務合約中的活動要求。「香港鼓 樂節開幕式」有幸作為香港重整經 濟活動之一,為配合鼓動港人在經 濟低迷及非典型肺炎疫症後發奮圖 、樂團即使面對臨時縮減兩個多 月的籌備時間,全體行政人員仍全 力以赴,通宵達旦在維多利亞公園 為廣大市民放置三千多個不同類型 的中國鼓,安排製造及運送最大的 中國鼓和銅鑼,於翌日攝氏33度高 溫下繼續協助整個活動的後勤工 作,再加上其他如鼓令比賽、鳴鼓 指數任您敲、展覽和戶外示範演出 等等,涉及龐大的聯絡工作和危機 處理。全體行政人員本著奉獻音樂 藝術的熱誠,以社會公益和服務藝 術為目的,正正以行動發揮了「香 港鼓樂節」團體精神及激勵鬥志的 深層意義!

最後,我感謝理事會對我的信任和 指導、社會各界的支持、藝術部團 員的貢獻,還有行政部全體同事的 熱誠,讓樂團的藝術行政工作能發 揮它的社會效能。

The SARS outbreak brought to the fore all the underlying strengths that have made Hong Kong what it is today - a world city!

Since its incorporation in 2001, and as a non-profit-distributing organization, the Hong Kong Chinese Orchestra has always been striving to be one of the companies with the best corporate practice. To ensure best corporate practice, disclosure and transparency are essential. We aim to provide ample information for our stakeholders and to account for the utilization of the funds received from the public. We also aim to improve public understanding of the structure, policies and activities of the Orchestra so as to enhance its reputation and respect as a world-class orchestra.

The Council

Council Structure

Management of the Orchestra is overseen by the Council which comprises ten Non-Executive Directors from diverse backgrounds. The two Principal Executives, i.e., the Artistic Director and the Executive Director also participate in Council meetings on a regular basis. All members participate actively in analyzing issues through in-depth and thorough discussions and provide independent professional advice in the furtherance of their duties so as to arrive at a conclusion in the best interests of the Orchestra.

Role and Responsibilities of Council

The Council is responsible for overall strategy, implementation and delegation of policy, approval of annual budget and artistic direction, approval of budget for major and special projects or related financial matters like overseas touring projects and the "Hong Kong Drum Festival Opening Rally", which was part of the Re-launch Hong Kong Project. The Council also monitors the strategic direction, financial status and progress of the Orchestra's subsidiaries: Hong Kong Children Chinese Orchestra Limited, Hong Kong Young Chinese Orchestra Limited and Hong Kong Junior Chinese Orchestra Limited. The Council bears the ultimate responsibility for the management of the Orchestra through close monitoring, strategy formulation, decision making and provision of guidance. Day-to-day operation of the Orchestra is delegated to the Artistic Director and Executive Director jointly.

The Chairman ensures that the Council goes through enlightened and considered decision-making processes. Council Members participate actively in analyzing the subject under discussion, approaching this from various perspectives. Options are carefully examined to assess the potential impact on the numerous stakeholders. The diverse backgrounds of the Council Members ensure that views are expressed and that conclusions balance the interests of all stakeholders. Decisions are made after due diligence in consideration of matters and in exercising rational judgment on the basis of facts and figures, financial and organizational effects, feasibility of each project, the public interest and various alternatives.

Meetings and Attendance of the Council

The Council and Committees have a formal schedule of matters reserved for them and they meet regularly in a pattern ranging from bi-monthly to quarterly during the year. The Principal Executives or Members may request the Council to convene a special meeting in case of emergency or under a special situation, either held in the form of a regular meeting or by circulation in special circumstances.

Except for those meetings convened under emergencies or exceptional cases, Council and Committee meetings are conducted in accordance with the following procedures:

Remuneration and Development of the Council and Senior Administration Staff

All non-executive directors of the Council serve the Orchestra on a pro bono publico basis.

The remuneration of senior administration executives is determined by the Council on the same basis as other employees of the Orchestra, in an open contract term. Total staff cost for 2004 amounted to HK\$41.2 million, compared to HK\$40.5 million in 2003.

Apart from organizing value-added workshops with selected subjects facilitated by Council Members and Annual Retreats for the Council and all staff, the Council encourages its members to pursue continuing director development. All Council Members and the two Principal Executives are now members of The Hong Kong Institute of Directors, participating from time to time in speaker meetings and training courses of the Institute and all have access to the Institute's guidelines and updates on director practices. The Chairman and one member of the Council, in particular, are frequently engaged in training directors and speaking at forums on corporate governance. The Artistic Director has obtained a Certificate in the Role of Company Directors and the Executive Director has obtained a Professional Diploma in Corporate Governance and Directorship.

Terms of Office

According to the Articles of Association of the Orchestra, the Council consists of no less than six members and no more than 20 members. Two-thirds of the Council are elected by Members of the Company and one-third is appointed by the Government of the HKSAR, the funding body. The term of office of elected Council Members is two years and 50% of the elected Council Members must retire at each AGM with eligibility to be re-elected to allow for turnover and continuity. The term of office of appointed Council Members is one year.

The Council has a nomination process whereby new candidates identified for election to the Council are formally proposed for consideration at a Council meeting, on the basis of the candidate's skill-set, willingness to dedicate time and effort to Council work, team-playing inclination, appreciation and support of the mission of the Company, network and other potential value to be added to the Company. Donation to the Company is not a consideration for appointment to the Council.

Finance and Audit Committee

Role, Function and Independence

The Finance and Audit Committee consists of five Council members. Its main responsibilities are to oversee the financial performance, budgetary control, accounting policies and internal financial control of the Orchestra. The Executive Director presents monthly financial statements to the Committee which takes a completely independent view to enforce an internal control before endorsement.

Attendance at meetings and Composition of the Committee are specified on pages 31 and 32.

Internal Review

• The Finance and Audit Committee exercises strategic internal control of the finance issues of the Orchestra. Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) were introduced this year to enable a better monitoring of the financial performance of the Orchestra. It has also undergone a review of procurement procedures, authority levels and tender procedures. As a recipient of public funding, the Company is subject to internal audit reviews arranged by the LCSD. Two reviews have taken place recently: a study of internal control and procedures by the ICAC and a value-for-money study by the Quality Assurance Section of the LCSD. The Finance and Audit Committee works closely with the management to scrutinize reports from these reviews and take action if necessary.

Risk Management

To cope with the ever changing environment, it is deemed necessary for the Orchestra to be fully aware of its opportunities and threats. The Committee is thus planning to set up internal audit for the orchestra and identify consultants to perform planning work so as to formulate its strategy towards the acute financial status and other underlying risks.

• Accounting and Procurement Manual

In order to provide clear instructions to the staff about the Orchestra's accounting and procurement procedures, the Orchestra has compiled its first Accounting Manual, consolidating guidelines on various procedures created over the past three years.

Human Resources Committee

Role, Function and Independence

The Committee consists of five Council members and two Principal Executives, i.e. the Artistic Director and the Executive Director. The Committee's role is to formulate policies and monitor organization, recruitment, development, staff appraisal and remuneration. With the two Principal Executives as representatives of members of the Orchestra, the Committee takes an in-depth, all-round but independent view to fulfill its role and function.

Internal Review

• Staff Development

The Orchestra employs 106 employees, plus project staff employed on contract basis. Employees are remunerated according to the nature of their work, qualifications, experience and market trend. Salary increments are at the sole discretion of the Orchestra in view of individual staff's performance as well as the



Orchestra's financial condition. Due to the current economic downturn and increasing subvention cuts from the LCSD, the Orchestra finds it difficult to reward staff performance in monetary terms. However, the Human Resources Committee introduced policies and measures to encourage artistic and administration staff to make full use of staff development opportunities.

• Human Resources Manual

In order to establish a clear set of guidelines with respect to the Orchestra's human resources policies and procedures, the Orchestra has compiled its first Human Resources Manual, consolidating guidelines on various procedures created over the past three years.
Marketing Committee

Role, Function and Independence

The Committee consists of four Council members and two Principal Executives, i.e. the Artistic Director and the Executive Director. Government funding has been gradually reducing each year. In spite of reduced grants, with a market focus and sensitivity, the Committee formulates policies and marketing strategies to reach new market segments and potential sponsors. HKCO is an identifiable brand in the world of Chinese orchestral music and is a pioneer in many ways to open up new markets. The recording of SACD has set a precedent as the world's first SACD live recording for a full-scale Chinese orchestra.

Internal Review

Audience Survey

The Committee carried out an in-depth review of the Report of HKCO Audience Survey conducted by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. Favorable comments on the branding and activities standard of the Orchestra were received, although it is deemed necessary to keep up our standard and extend our promotion and marketing strategies in a more diversified direction, even with restricted funding.

Review of Report on Marketing Strategies

A report on the Orchestra's marketing strategies was completed by the Executive Director and submitted for the Committee's review. With extensive experience in their respective fields, members of the Committee have provided valuable and fruitful suggestions for future development. Keeping cost-effective promotion activities as a principle, new strategies on brand building, positioning in the global market and on the 4Ps - product, price, place and promotion were thoroughly discussed in meetings. A meeting with marketing consultants is also planned to formulate and review our marketing strategies.

Raising Funds

In the new era of the 21st century, all performing arts groups in the world are facing severe competition, not only from the classical arts field, but also from a variety of entertainments and the continuous production of new digital products. Various fund raising activities and projects are planned to develop new audiences and increase the Orchestra's income.

Education Committee

Role, Function and Independence

The promotion of Chinese music among youngsters in schools is a significant issue. The Education Committee was established for strategic planning and formulating promotion programmes of Chinese music among schools. The Committee consists of four Council members, one co-opted member and two Principal Executives, i.e. the Artistic Director and the Executive Director. Dr Cham Lai Suk Ching Estella kindly accepted our invitation to be a Member of the Education Committee, a great honour for the Orchestra. Dr Cham, as Music Advisor of the Orchestra, has worked with the Education Department for many years and has extensive experience in the



organization of art education. She is the first co-opted Committee Member of the Orchestra.

Attendance at meetings and Composition of the Committee are specified on pages 31 and 32.

Internal Review

Chinese Instrument Courses for Schools

The Education Committee has been exercising strategic control on the development of Chinese music promotion activities and Chinese instrument courses among schools and community centres. An audience survey exercise on our outreach activities was carried out to keep us close to the market.

• Meet-the-teacher Sessions

In order to ensure policies and measures meet environmental expectations and standards, a total of four "meet-the-teachers" sessions were organized to communicate with the principals and teachers from both primary and secondary schools. Over 80 representatives from 60 schools participated in the project and the Orchestra has introduced immediate follow-up activities like student guided concerts and the planning of a Gala Chinese music performance for schools.

• Scholarships and Guidelines for Setting Up a Chinese Orchestra

Scholarships and financial assistance were offered to members of the Hong Kong Children Chinese Orchestra and Chinese Instrument Courses during the year to assist talented youngsters with financial difficulties to have a chance to develop their potential. During the year, the Orchestra has compiled guidelines on the setting up of a Chinese Orchestra and Chinese orchestral music environment. The guidelines are distributed free to teachers and have been uploaded on the Orchestra website for international access.

Stakeholders Relations

The Council meets regularly for brainstorming ideas in its review of the existing strategies, as well as to discuss the formulation of future strategies. Representatives from the LCSD attend all Council meetings and offer advice on the running of the Orchestra when necessary. Various communication channels are opened up to all members of the Orchestra, as well as a continuous close dialogue with the representatives of the LCSD. Harmonious working relations are sustained to ensure that different parties work hand in hand for the best interests of the Orchestra. As a non-profit-distributing organization providing service to the people of Hong Kong, public relations are also emphasized by providing adequate and up-to-date information on the activities of the Orchestra in a user-friendly manner.

理事會的職能和責任

理事會主席確保理事會決策過程開明而周全。理事積極分析研討事項,從 多角度深入研究,繼而再審核各方案對權益相關者的潛在影響。理事來自 不同背景,有效確保理事作出均衡的意見,以及平衡所有權益相關者利益 的結論。經過詳盡的研究,理事基於事實和數據、對財務和組織的影響、 項目可行性、公眾利益以及其他可選方案而作出合理的決策。

The Group and the Company present symphonic music based on traditional folk repertoires and full-scale contemporary compositions. The principal activities of the Group and the Company consist of providing Chinese music programmes of different styles to blend the diverse artistic expressions and techniques of today with the traditional culture of China in interpretation of metropolitan life, as well as rendering promotion, education, research and development of traditional and modern Chinese music. There were no significant changes in the nature of the Group's principal activities during the year.

Results

The Group's surplus for the year ended 31 March 2004 and the state of affairs of the Company and the Group at that date are set out in the financial statements on pages 59 to 75.

1. CORPORATION INFORMATION

The Company was incorporated in Hong Kong on 7 February 2001 with limited liability by guarantee. The liability of the Members is limited to HK\$100 per Member.

The registered office of the Company is located at 7/F, Sheung Wan Municipal Services Building, 345 Queen's Road Central, Hong Kong.

During the year, the Group and the Company was involved in providing Chinese music programmes of different styles to blend the diverse artistic expressions and techniques of today with the traditional culture of China in interpretation of metropolitan life, as well as rendering promotion, education, research and development of traditional and modern Chinese music.

Pursuant to the Government's approval on 14 August 2002, a Development Fund was set up for the funding of non-subvented activities which fall outside the ambit of Government subvention and will be used for organising events and activities to further promote Chinese music. The General Fund accounts for all Government subvented activities and the Development Fund accounts for all non-subvented activites. The council members consider that it is more appropriate to present the financial results and positions of these funds as separate columns to reflect the actual results of these funds.

2. IMPACT OF A NEW STATEMENT OF STANDARD ACCOUNTING PRACTICE ("SSAP")

The new SSAP 35 "Accounting for government grants and disclosure of government assistance" is effective for the first time for the current year's financial statements.

SSAP 35 prescribes the accounting for government grants and other forms of government assistance. The adoption of this SSAP has had no significant impact for these financial statements on the amounts recorded for government grants, however, additional disclosures are now required and are detailed in notes 3 and 4 to the financial statements.

3. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of presentation

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Hong Kong Statements of Standard Accounting Practice, accounting principles generally accepted in Hong Kong and the Companies Ordinance. They have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

31 March 2004

Basis of consolidation

The consolidated financial statements include the financial statements of the Company and its subsidiaries for the year ended 31 March 2004. The results of subsidiaries acquired or disposed of during the year are consolidated from or to their effective dates of acquisition or disposal, respectively. All significant intercompany transactions and balances within the Group are eliminated on consolidation.

Subsidiaries

A subsidiary is a company in which the Company, directly or indirectly, controls more than half of its voting power or issued share capital or controls the composition of its board of directors.

The results of subsidiaries are included in the Company's statement of income and expenditure to the extent of dividends received and receivable. The Company's interests in subsidiaries are stated at cost less any impairment losses.

Related parties

Parties are considered to be related if one party has the ability, directly or indirectly, to control the other party or exercise significant influence over the other party in making financial and operating decisions. Parties are also considered to be related if they are subject to common control or common significant influence. Related parties may be individuals or corporate entities.

Revenue recognition

Revenue is recognised when it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the Group and when the revenue can be measured reliably, on the following bases:

- (a) contributions from sponsors and donations, on a cash receipt basis or in the period as specified by the donor;
- (b) performance fees, on an accrual basis;
- (c) interest income, on a time proportion basis taking into account the principal outstanding and the effective interest rate applicable; and
- (d) membership fees, on a cash receipt basis.

Fixed assets

Expenditure on fixed assets is expensed when incurred.

31 March 2004

Operating leases

Leases where substantially all the rewards and risks of ownership of assets remain with the lessor are accounted for as operating leases. Rentals payable under the operating leases are charged to the statement of income and expenditure on the straight-line basis over the lease terms.

Foreign currency transactions

Foreign currency transactions are recorded at the applicable exchange rates ruling at the transaction dates. Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies at the balance sheet date are translated at the applicable exchange rates ruling at that date. Exchange differences are dealt with in the statement of income and expenditure.

Cash and cash equivalents

For the purpose of the consolidated cash flow statement, cash and cash equivalents comprise cash on hand and demand deposits, and short term highly liquid investments which are readily convertible into known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value, and have a short maturity of generally within three months when acquired, less bank overdrafts which are repayable on demand and form an integral part of the Group's cash management.

For the purpose of the balance sheet, cash equivalents comprise cash on hand and at banks, including term deposits, which are not restricted as to use.

Government grants

Government grants are recognised at their fair value where there is reasonable assurance that the grant will be received and all attaching conditions will be complied with. When the grant relates to an expense item, it is recognised as income over the periods necessary to match the grant on a systematic basis to the costs that it is intended to compensate.

Employee benefits

Paid leave carried forward

The Group provides paid annual leave to its employees under their employment contracts on a calendar year basis. Under certain circumstances, such leave which remains untaken as at the balance sheet date is permitted to be carried forward and utilised by the respective employees in the following year. An accrual is made at the balance sheet date for the expected future cost of such paid leave earned during the year by the employees and carried forward.

31 March 2004

Pension scheme

The Group operates a defined contribution Mandatory Provident Fund retirement benefits scheme (the "MPF Scheme") under the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Ordinance, for those employees who are eligible to participate in the MPF Scheme. Contributions are made based on a percentage of the employees' basic salaries and are charged to the statement of income and expenditure as they become payable in accordance with the rules of the MPF Scheme. The assets of the MPF Scheme are held separately from those of the Group in an independently administered fund. The Group's employer contributions vest fully with the employees when contributed into the MPF Scheme.

Development fund

Development fund was established for the funding of non-subvented activities, which fall outside the ambit of Government subvention. Development fund raised funds from public by soliciting donations and organising Chinese music related events.

4. GOVERNMENT SUBSIDY

The Group's Government subsidy represents subsidy from the Leisure and Cultural Services Department of the Government of the HKSAR for providing Chinese musical programmes of different styles. There are no unfulfilled conditions or contingencies relating to these grants.

1. 公司資料

本公司於2001年2月7日在香港成立及註冊為有擔保有限責任公司。 每名公司會員財務責任上限為港幣100元。

本公司的註冊地址為香港上環皇后大道中345號上環市政大廈7樓。

年內,本集團與公司提供不同類型的中樂節目,結合當代多種不同 藝術表現手法與傳統文化以演繹大都會的生活,以及積極宣傳推廣、 教育、研究和發展傳統和現代中國音樂。

本公司於2002年8月14日獲政府批准成立發展基金,以資助一些不 被列入於受政府資助的活動範圍內之中國音樂推廣活動。本公司的普 通基金是用於受政府資助的活動上,而發展基金則用於非受政府資助 的活動上。理事會認為將兩項基金的財務結果及狀況分開呈列能更恰 當地反映不同基金的實際業績。

2. 新制定及經修訂香港會計實務準則 (「會計實務準則」) 之影響

新制定的會計實務準則第35號有關「政府撥款會計及政府資助披露」 首次於本年度的財務報表生效及應用。

會計實務準則第35號訂明政府撥款及其他形式資助的會計事宜。採納 此會計實務準則對財務報表內錄得的政府資助並無重大影響,惟新準 則要求在有關方面更詳盡的披露。有關的詳情載列於財務報表附註第 3頁至第4頁。

3. 主要會計政策

編製財務報表之準則

本財務報表乃根據香港會計師公會修訂之所有適用的《會計實務準則》 及詮釋、香港公認會計準則及《公司條例》的規定編製。本財務報表 是以歷史成本作為編製基準。

綜合基準

綜合財務報表包括本公司及其附屬公司截至2004年3月31日止年度 之財務報表。於本年度內所收購或出售之附屬公司業績,分別由收購 生效日期起綜合計算或綜合計算至出售生效日期止。本集團內公司間 之一切重大交易及結餘均於綜合帳目時抵銷。

附屬公司

附屬公司為本公司直接或間接操控其超過半數投票權或已發行股本或 董事局成員委任權之公司。

附屬公司之業績包括已收及應收股息,已列入本公司之收益帳內。本 公司於附屬公司之權益乃按成本扣除任何減值虧損後列帳。 財務報表附註

收入的入帳處理

收入是在經濟收益可能流入本集團,及能可靠地計算該等收入時,按 以下方法進行入帳的:

(a) 贊助及捐款乃在收到有關款項時入帳或按照捐款人指定的期間進行 入帳。

- (b)演出收入乃在已提供有關服務時入帳。
- (c) 銀行存款所產生之利息收入乃參考存款之金額及適用利率以時間 分配基準入帳。
- (d) 會費乃在收到有關款項時入帳。

固定資產

固定資產的原值會於購置有關資產時立即全部報銷。

經營租賃

若有關資產的擁有權之相關風險及回報仍然落在出租人身上者,則該 租賃將會被視為經營租賃來處理。經營租賃費用按個別租賃項目之年 期以直線法計入收益帳內。

外幣兑換

以外幣結算之交易按交易日之匯率換算為港元。以外幣為單位的貨幣 性資產及負債則按結算日的匯率換算為港元。外幣兑換差額已於收益 帳內處理。

現金及等同現金項目

就綜合現金流量表而言,現金及等同現金項目包括現金及活期存款, 以及高度流通之短期投資,此等投資只有影響細微的風險並可隨時兑 換為可知數額之現金,一般於購入後三個月內到期,減去即期支付之 銀行透支,從而組成本集團現金管理部分。

就資產負債表而言,現金及等同現金項目包括現金及銀行存款、定期 存款,及性質與現金相似無限制使用之資產。

政府撥款

在相當肯定獲取撥款並履行所有附帶條件的時候,政府撥款即以其公 平價值入帳。若撥款與某支出項目相連,有關撥款應有系統地按期計 入收入以抵銷相關成本。

僱員福利

有薪假期結轉

本集團按日曆年度根據僱員合約向僱員提供有薪假期。在若干情況 下,僱員於結算日還沒享用之有薪假期會獲准結轉至來年享用。僱員 在本年度有薪假期之未來估計成本將於結算日作為應計負債並結轉至 來年。

退休福利計劃

本集團根據《強制性公積金計劃條例》為合資格僱員提供定額供款退 休福利計劃(「強積金計劃」)。根據該強積金計劃之規則,供款按合資 格僱員基本薪金之百分比計算,於應付時從收益帳中扣除。該強積金 計劃之資產由獨立管理之基金持有,並與本集團之資產分開。而本集 團就該強積金計劃之有關僱主供款,則於供款後即為僱員所有。

發展基金

發展基金成立的目的在於資助一些不被列入為受政府資助的活動。 發展基金的收益來自公眾的捐款及舉辦中樂活動所得的盈餘。
